<b>January 19, 2023</b>	<b>The 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Instantiation of the Ostrom Workshop</b>	Today we celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the instantiation of the Ostrom Workshop at <a href="#">Indiana University Bloomington</a> by Lin and Vincent Ostrom. An idea inspired from working with carpenters to build furniture for their home, the Workshop became a place where thousands of apprentices, students, and scholars from multiple countries and disciplines learned from one another. It continues to echo Lin and Vincent's beliefs that understanding good research demands a vast array of skills and methods, and that collaboration is essential. Join us in celebrating their legacy!
<b>January 23, 2023</b>	<b>Ribbon Cutting Ceremony, Celebratory Colloquium, and Lunch Reception</b>	Join the IU Provost Rahul Shrivastav and the Office of the Vice President of Research's Brea Perry as we cut the ribbon on our new porch and begin the official celebration of the 50 years with the Ostrom Workshop. Dr. Lauren MacLean presents the first Colloquium of the year and it is followed by a catered lunch and cake.
<b>March 8, 2023</b>	<b>International Women's Day</b>	Celebrate Elinor Ostrom's distinction of the first woman to receive the Nobel Prize in Economics. In recognition, the Workshop will reveal their new lamp post flags in front of 513 N. Park Avenue AND partner with the IU Museum of Archeology & Anthropology (IUMAA) for a special online exhibit of the Ostrom artifacts.

<b>April 17, 2023</b>	<b>Barb Allen visit and Hootenany</b>	Ostrom student Barb Allen and guest speaker Professor Lindsey Flynn visit the Workshop. Barb Allen hosts the Colloquium and Linsey Flynn to provide a research talk. As a nod to the hootenany's of past Workshoppers, an evening of appetizers and music is planned.
<b>April 23-29, 2023</b>	<b>Earth Day and Lin's Uncommon Life Book Launch</b>	The Ostrom Workshop will celebrate Earth Day with relevant speakers throughout the Month of April along with a celebratory Research Series on April 26, 2023 and a book launch and signing of the children's book about Elinor Ostrom's life, by Scott Shackelford and Emily Castle, "Lin's Uncommon Life".

<b>September 2023</b>	<b>First Colloquium, Celebration of the Commons Research</b>	The first colloquium of our 50 <sup>th</sup> fall will be a unique two hour colloquium with a special Commons Panel moderated by Insa Theesfeld (former Commons director), and a Commons Themed Colloquium to honor the Ostrom's Work and Research in this area.
<b>October 2023</b>	<b>Ostrom Memorial Lecture and Banquet</b>	The Ostrom Memorial Lecture will be a lovely event with an Introduction by Executive Director Scott Shackelford reflecting on the progression of the Workshop over the past 50 years and an honorary speaker. Following will be a Jacobs School of Music Reception for all attendees and an invitation only banquet in the library.
<b>TBD</b>	<b>Pavilion Ground Breaking</b>	In honor of the Ostrom's emphasis on collaboration, the Ostrom Workshop will build an outdoor pavilion for gatherings and discussions on Park Avenue. A ceremonial groundbreaking will be planned.
