The Ostroms' work has been adapted to a wide range of sectors and disciplines, from fisheries and forests to climate change and, more recently, the final frontier. There's a growing literature on applying polycentric principles to space governance, and more broadly addressing collective action problems including orbital debris and space weaponization.

Given recent developments including constellations of satellites going up on scarce orbits, and even asteroid mining, this group will explore current work in this field and seek out opportunities for collaboration including with Université Laval, in Québec, Canada.
