Building a framework of stability and accountability in cyberspace

Chris Painter is a globally recognized leader and expert on cybersecurity and cyber policy, Cyber Diplomacy and combatting cybercrime. He has been on the vanguard of U.S. and international cyber issues for over twenty five years—first as a prosecutor of some of the most high-profile cybercrime cases in the country and then as a senior official at the Department of Justice, FBI, the National Security Council and finally the State Department. In this talk Painter will discuss the threats the US faces in cyberspace particularly from nation-state actors and the need to achieve long term cyber stability to enable the positive developments that information technologies bring to the world's economies and societies. He will address a “cyber stability framework” comprised of international law, norms of state behavior (or rules of the road) and confidence building measures and the diplomatic efforts that have advanced this framework internationally.
